## I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy establishes the KYOCERA AVX Components Corporation (KAVX) corporate requirements with applicable mineral sourcing laws, regulations and related KAVX procedures.

KAVX is dedicated to sourcing minerals in a way that promotes ethical practices, respects human rights, complies with global regulations, and supports sustainable development. Sourcing of minerals can have significant economic, social, and environmental impacts, particularly when those minerals are extracted from conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

This revised version broadens the policy by incorporating detailed supplier audits, enhanced due diligence practices, and capacity-building initiatives. It emphasizes sustainability by aligning with the Environment, Health and Safety (ESG) principles. Additionally, it strengthens transparency and collaboration while establishing robust grievance mechanisms to address concerns effectively.

# II. SCOPE

This policy applies to all materials and components procured, manufactured, or sold by KAVX, as well as to all suppliers and business partners within our global supply chain.

# V. POLICY

# Principles

# 1. Compliance with Applicable Laws and Standards

KAVX complies with all applicable local, national, and international laws and regulations regarding responsible mineral sourcing, including but not limited to Section 1502 of the U.S. Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, the EU Conflict Minerals Regulation (EU 2017/821), and relevant Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) Guidelines. We also monitor and align with emerging standards and practices in mineral sourcing to ensure ongoing compliance.

# 2. Commitment to Conflict-Free Minerals

We strive to ensure that the tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold (3TG) and cobalt used in our products are responsibly sourced and do not directly or indirectly finance armed conflict or human rights abuses in conflict-affected and high-risk areas or any other areas in the world. We actively support initiatives that promote conflict-free sourcing and encourage the development of conflict-free supply chains.

# 3. Due Diligence

KAVX implements a comprehensive due diligence process based on the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas. This process includes:

- Identifying and assessing risks in our supply chain through rigorous risk mapping and analysis.
- Requiring suppliers to complete detailed due diligence questionnaires to validate their sourcing practices.
- Conducting supplier audits and evaluations to ensure alignment with responsible sourcing practices.
- Encouraging suppliers to source from smelters and refiners validated as conformant with recognized industry standards, such as the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP) and RMI <u>https://www.responsiblemineralsinitiative.org/</u>
- Developing and implementing risk mitigation plans for suppliers not meeting compliance expectations.

- Source minerals only from smelters and refiners that are validated as conformant with recognized industry standards as well as current trade sanctions internationally.
